Majesty (1-4)

Still another (of the same kind) angel (John 14:16)

Seven thunders – a shout like the roar of a lion (John 12:29-31/Exodus 20:19)

Seal them up

Things we cannot bear until later (Daniel 12:9 / John 16:12)

Things we do not need to know (Deuteronomy 29:29)

Mystery (5-7)

Raised hand toward heaven (I Timothy 2:8/Psalm 63:4)

Recognition of the One who created everything (Colossians 1:15-17)

Realization of the time (Ephesians 5:15-16/Colossians 4:5)

Remembering His promises – all will be fulfilled (II Corinthians 1:20)

Mouth (8-11)

Acquiring the Book – take the Scroll from the angel (Deuteronomy 18:18-19)

Asked to eat it – taking in His word (Ezekiel 2:1 – 3:4)

Sweet to our understanding (John 15:15)

Sour for those receiving His judgments (Matthew 12:34-36/Isaiah 28:21)

Announcing what is to come (Amos 3:7/Luke 24:25)
