The 144,000 (1-5)

Standing with Jesus on Mount Zion (Hebrews 12:22-24)

Our desire to be with Jesus on His Holy Mountain

Secured in the Father's Name (Ephesians 3:14-15 / Hebrews 12:10)

The source of all fatherhood is our God, the perfect Father

Singing a new song (Psalm 96:1-4)

He gives us a reason to sing / He puts a new song in our hearts

Staying pure (Exodus 19:15 / Leviticus 15:18 / Hebrews 13:4)

Abstaining from anything that can make us impure

Serving their Lord

Following the Lamb (Mark 18:34)

Wherever He leads us

Firstfruits offered to God (I Corinthians 15:20, 23 / James 1:18)

Sacrificing our lives to Him (Romans 12:1)

Found blameless (Philippians 2:14-16 / Colossians 1:22)

In our attitude, speech, and actions / He is the One who transform us

The angels (6-8)

The Eternal Gospel (Jonah 2:9)

Salvation is of our God and always by faith

Proclaimed to every person (Romans 1:19-20/Colossians 1:6, 23/Revelation 1:6)

Whether through creation, His church, or angelic messengers

Power of God (Jeremiah 32:17 / Luke 18:26-27)

In the gospel is the power to save (Romans 1:16)

He is to be feared (Psalm 111:10 / Proverbs 29:25) ***we gain perspective from God***

He alone is to be worshipped (Luke 4:8) ***not creation, but the Creator***

He is bringing His judgments upon the earth (Isaiah 24:1-3) ***like it or not***

He is your Creator (Psalm 24:1-6) ***we belong to Him/and are to seek Him***

The empty promise (II Peter 2:19) ***nothing else satisfies, only Jesus***

The fall of Babylon (Matthew 4:8-9; 6:19-21 / II Corinthians 4:16-18)

All that is of this world will perish

The fall of the nations who shared in her adulteries (Philippians 3:18-20)

***Our focus is either on the world or Christ, we cannot have both
(James 4:4)***

Discussion questions for Revelation 14:1-8

What privileges given to the 144,000 are also given to His church?

(John 17:24 / I John 3:2): ***We will be with Jesus – we will see Him as He is
We will stand by Him through the Millennium and in Heaven***

(Ephesians 3:14-15 / Acts 4:12; 10:43): ***We bear His Name as His children (I John 3:1)
Therefore, we are under His love and His protection***

(Psalm 40:3 / Revelation 5:9-10): ***We have been given a new heart and new
understanding, that we might sing a new song (Colossians 3:16). Expressing
praise to our Savior.***

(Titus 2:14): ***We are His, redeemed by Him and for Him, made to serve Him
We are made to do the work He created us for (Ephesians 2:10)***

Describe how we can practically serve the LORD in the same manner as the 144,000.

Follow the Lamb (Ruth 1:16-17 / Luke 14:25-27, 33): ***We are willing to follow Him
anywhere and be named among His people. We are to give Him first place
in our lives: over self, family, and finances.***

Firstfruits offered to God (Romans 6:11-14; 12:1): ***Offering my life to my Redeemer -
sacrificing all for Him. Offering the parts of my body as instruments of
righteousness for His purpose.***

Found blameless (Philippians 2:12-16 / Titus 2:11-13): ***Saying 'No' to ungodliness and
'Yes' to Jesus by the power of His grace as I eagerly await His appearing.
Allowing His to have His way without grumbling or complaining (that is with
joy and thanksgiving)***

How is the gospel the same and how is it different in the O.T., the church age, and the tribulation?

(Genesis 12:3 / Galatians 3:8-9): ***O. T. – Based on a future promise whereas our faith
is based on a finished event (His death & resurrection)***

(Genesis 15:4 / Romans 4:23-25): ***O.T. – trusting that God will fulfill His word – we trust
what is recorded in His Word regarding His work on the Cross***

(Psalm 32:1-2, 5 / Romans 4:5-8): ***O. T. – believing the God can forgive our sins – we
know that He has paid for our forgiveness on the Cross***

(I Corinthians 15:3-4): ***we must believe that Jesus died on the Cross for our sins and
that He rose on the 3rd day according to the Scriptures***

(Revelation 14:6-7): ***TRIB – He is God! His judgments are true! He is my Creator!***
