

Revelation 14:9-20
Rejecting the Message

Those who worship the beast (9-13) (Ephesians 2:2)

Receiving the mark = receiving the fury of God (Ezekiel 9:4 / Revelation 7:3)

Rising torment forever (II Thessalonians 1:8-9 / Revelation 19:20; 20:10)

Rest will never happen (Psalm 95:10-11 / Hebrews 4:10-11)

Remaining faithful (Hebrews 10:23)

Requires patient endurance (Romans 5:3-5/James 1:2-4/I Corinthians 10:12-13)

Rest is found in death (Isaiah 57:1-2)

Thrown into the winepress of God's wrath (Revelation 5:6-7 / John 5:22-23)

The harvesters – God's angels (John 14:1-3 / I Thessalonians 4:16)

The gathering – grapes that are ripened

The trampling – God's winepress (Jeremiah 25:15-17)

The overflow – gruesome amounts of blood (Joel 3:13-14)
