His character is pure (Hebrews 6:17-18)
His promises are secure (II Corinthians 1:20-22)

Holding the Key of David (II Samuel 7:15-16 / Daniel 7:13-14)

Door that is open (II Corinthians 6:2 / Isaiah 55:6)
For those with little strength (Zechariah 4:6 / I Corinthians 1:26-31)
For those who keep His Word (John 8:31-32 / II Timothy 4:1-2)
For those who do not deny His Name (Psalm 138:2 / Philippians 2:10)

Door that is closed (Matthew 25:10)
For those of the synagogue of Satan
For those who are liars (Revelation 21:8)
For those who will one day acknowledge their error (Revelation 20:12)

Hour of trial

The testing – coming upon the whole world (Isaiah 34:1-3; 63:6 / Hebrews 12:27)

The escape – those who patiently endure (I Thessalonians 5:9)

Hold on to what you have (Philippians 3:16)

His coming is soon (Revelation 1:3; 22:20)
