GRUMBLING (41-52)

Beginning to turn **away** (Luke 14:25-26)

How can He say, “I AM the **bread** of life”? (Genesis 3:1)
How can He say, “I came **down** from heaven”?

Being **taught** by God (Isaiah 54:13) – the answer to grumbling

No one comes to Jesus unless the Father **draws** him (John 12:32; 15:26)
Everyone who **listens** and learns from the Father will come to Jesus

No one has **seen** the Father except Jesus (John 1:18)
Everyone who believes **has** everlasting life (John 3:16; 5:24)

JESUS is the **BREAD** of LIFE

Those who ate the **manna** still died

Those who eat the **true** bread will not die

To eat the **living** bread (Jesus) is to live forever

The bread is His **flesh** – He gives it for the life of the world (I Timothy 2:5-6)

DOUBT (52-58)

How can He give us His flesh to **eat**? (John 4:32-33)

How we must understand the **truth** concerning the eating of His flesh

If you will not eat and drink, you will not have **life** (I Corinthians 11:25-27)

If you will eat and drink of Him, you **have** eternal life and will be raised

His flesh is real **food**, and His blood is real drink! (John 6:63)

If you eat and drink you will **abide** in Him and He is you (John 15:4)

If you **feed** on Him, whom the living Father sent, you will live (John 17:3)

His **flesh** is the bread of heaven, feed on it and live forever
