Revelation 19:11-21 The Second Coming

Presenting Our LORD (11-16) – who is the KING of kings and the LORD of lords

Faithful and True - He is the ROCK upon which we can stand

In all He says (Proverbs 30:5) – *His Word is flawless* In all His promises (II Corinthians 1:20) – *He fulfills them ALL* In all He does (Lamentations 3:22-23) – *Great is His faithfulness* (*Psalm 145:13b*)

Fire filled eyes - His fury and wrath are aroused

Anger toward those who harm His people (Revelation 2:18) - *He loves* Appalled that there one no one to bring justice (Isaiah 59:16) – *He judges*

For Him only – His Name: the Word of God (John 1:1, 14) His Name is beyond comprehension (Gen. 32:29/Jdg. 13:18/Is. 9:6)

Followers – dressed in white (Revelation 19:8; 3:4-5; 7:13-14)

All who have been robed in the righteousness of Christ

Fury of God's wrath - His patience does not last forever (II Peter 1:9-10)

Those who refuse His love (Hebrews 10:26-31) Those who refuse to listen (Hebrews 12:22-29)

Those who continue in wickedness

Final Authority – the KING of KINGS (Philippians 2:9-11) – Every knee will bow

Complete Sovereignty (Colossians 1:18) – *Supremacy is ALL things* Conforming everything to His will (Ephesians 1:11) – *His purpose stands!*

Prepared for Destruction (17-21)

Supper of God – for those who will not come (Matthew 22:1-14 / Revelation 19:7) *Refusing the invitation to the wedding banquet* Signs used to deceive (Matthew 24:24 / II Thessalonians 2:9-10) *We must stand on His Word, it does not change (Psalm 119:89, 96)* Sulfur burning in the Lake of Fire (Genesis 19:24 / Lamentations 4:6-8) *This should be a merciful death, but it never ends* Sword from His mouth – He can create and destroy (Isaiah 45:7) *To be His = the rapture / to not be His = the second death* Discussion questions for Revelation 19:11-21

How should we respond to a faithful and true Savior? (Psalm 29:1-2 / Proverbs 3:5-6 / Colossians 3:23 / II Corinthians 1:20) *I know that I can trust Him. He alone is worthy of my honor. It is always worth it to serve Him in everything I do. I can hope in His promises with a certain hope.*

Why is it not our place to judge? (Matthew 7:1-5/John 5:22-23/Romans 2:1-3/Jms. 4:11-12) I risk facing Judgment because I cannot see clearly. All judgment has been entrusted to Jesus – no one else is qualified. I am guilty myself; how then can I objectively pass judgment on someone else.

What is the significance of HIS NAME? (Exodus 3:14/Matthew 1:21/Acts 4:12; 5:41/ Philippians 2:9-10/Judges 13:18) **YHVH – He is the I AM. Only in His Name can salvation be found, for His Name, Yeshua, means salvation. His Name is above all other names, and every knee will confess that Name and bow before Him. His Name is Wonderful, it is beyond our comprehension.**

If I have a will, how does my will impact God? Myself? (Ephesians 4:30/Proverbs 21:30/ Romans 12:1/Hebrews 12:7-11) *I can grieve Him by my choices when I ignore His presence and power in my life. But I cannot thwart His purpose and plan no matter what I do. I can surrender my will to Him and live as He desires or I can be disciplined as His child in order to bring me back in line with His will.*

What blessings can come from taking this passage to heart? (Isaiah 33:6/Jude 14-15/Titus 2:14/Psalm 64:5-10/Romans 10:1-4) **Seeing who He truly is I can gain the blessing of** *understanding what it means to fear Him. I can recognize that I will ride with Him out of heaven when He come – whichs helps me now to focus on the blessed hope, when He returns to take me to be with Him (before the TRIB) I can rejoice that wickedness will one day be judged in righteousness. I am motivated to share Christ with other, that they might be spared from this judgment.*
