Ready to do His work (20-21) A vessel prepared for the Master's use

Cleansing – removing the ignoble (Hebrews 12:1 / Philippians 1:9-10) Not just my sin, but also things that hinder me from serving Not settling for what is good, but choosing what is best Consecrated – as an instrument for the Master's use (Ephesians 2:10) Knowing that He has good works already prepared for me Sanctified in Him – by His Word (John 17:17) & by His Spirit (Eph. 5:18) Righteousness pursued (22-26) Seeking Him, the source of my righteousness

Flee – the evil desires of youth (I Corinthians 6:18 / I Timothy 6:11 / I John 2:15-16)
The passions of the flesh – not even a hint (Ephesians 5:3)
The love of this world – focused on my true home (Philippians 3:20)
Follow – the righteous path of faith (Galatians 5:16 / I Corinthians 6:9-11 / Ephesians 5:1-4 / Colossians 3:12-15)
Faith expressed in love. Washed by His Spirit.
Following His example of love (I John 3:16-18)

Foolish – arguments avoided (I Timothy 1:6-7 / Titus 3:9-11)
Speaking confidently about things you do not understand (Jude 10)
Seeking controversies leading to arguments and divisiveness
Faithful – to gentle instruct those who oppose you (I Peter 3:15) with respect

The hope of God granting repentance (Romans 2:4)

His kindness leads to repentance

The knowledge of the truth (John 8:31-32)

A disciple who holds to His teaching learns truth & is set free The escape of the devil's trap (II Corinthians 4:4)

To remain blinded is to be a tool of the enemy (Ephesians 2:1-2)

Discussion questions for II Timothy 2:20-26

16) Entertainment (television, movies, sports, social media, gaming, etc.) 'News' (available 24/7) How much time is spent thus hindering time that could be used to serve our Lord.

Describe the path of faith.

(Ephesians 4:17-23) **A change of direction – REPENT and follow Jesus** (Psalm 25:4-5, 9, 12, 14) **A change of paths – humbling yourself and letting Him lead** (Psalm 119:105) **A change of steps – letting His Word direct my every step**

How are we to approach those who oppose us (i.e. unbelievers) in the hope of persuading them toward the truth? (II Timothy 2:24-25 / I Peter 3:13-16 / Colossians 4:5-6)

Do not be argumentative, but show kindness – gentleness in your instruction Be in the right place in your heart toward God – be gentle, showing respect to others Be in prayer – let the truth you share be wrapped in grace (Ephesians 4:15) truthing in love.

Remember that it is God's kindness that leads us to repentance (Romans 2:4)
