Ready to do His work (20-21)

Consecrated – as an instrument for the Master's use (Ephesians 2:10)

Righteousness pursued (22-26)

Flee – the evil desires of youth (I Corinthians 6:18 / I Timothy 6:11 / I John 2:15-16)

Follow – the righteous path of faith (Galatians 5:16 / I Corinthians 6:9-11 / Ephesians 5:1-4 / Colossians 3:12-15)

Foolish – arguments avoided (I Timothy 1:6-7 / Titus 3:9-11)

Faithful – to gently instruct those who oppose you (I Peter 3:15)

The hope of God granting repentance (Romans 2:4)

The knowledge of the truth (John 8:31-32)

The escape of the devil's trap (II Corinthians 4:4)
